Julie Wasson opened the meeting at 7:05pm with Jami Mitchell opening in prayer.

September Meeting Minutes (Hard copied and reviewed by all) Motion made by Christy Grygiel and approved by all

Treasury Report (Brett Dempsey)

First Nation Bank balance on September 30, 2011- 36,445.42 (total deposits \$7,240.00, no debits). Balance on October 10, 2011-\$43,685.42. Near term expenditures include a debit for \$8,135.00 for Entertainment Books.

Scrip (Becky Sander)

\$18,285 have been ordered in the first seven orders. \$380 profit has been made for the school. Christi Cristea suggested that anytime the school pays for something they buy that item with a gift card for added bonus to the school. We discussed having cards on hand. We all agreed that the risk is too great to keep these on hand.

Fundraising (Christy Grygiel)

Entertainment Books—Final total of books sold is 593. Our goal was 600. Kindergarten sold the most books.

Chevys Night-- To be held on February 11, 2011. This will be an all day event. The school will get 25% of all sales where the customer mentions FBCA. Flyers will be handed out before hand.

Movie Night—We will check with Anita Chalk for available dates in January. Everyone agreed no babysitting at this event but it was suggested that we have a coloring table set up in the back of the room for the younger children who will need a break from the movie.

McTeacher Night—Teacher sign up for a time slot to work at McDonalds. The school will get a percentage of EVERY person, not just FBCA families, that go to that McDonalds in a 4 hr window. We will try for a November date. Christi Cristea will get info on what this includes and Christy Grygiel will see if we have teachers willing to do this.

Old Business

Teacher luncheon is all set. Jami Mitchell has recruited all volunteers that are needed.

New Business

7th & 8th grade-- Groups are still working on the needs for 7th and 8th grade. We should expect to start seeing this by early 2012.

Red Wheel— We need to decide if we will be doing this again this year.
